Any person who believes they have been discriminated against on the basis of race color, or national origin by North East Transportation may file a Title VI complaint. Complaints must be filed, in writing, no more than 180 day(s) from the date(s) of the alleged incident, or the date when the person(s) became aware of the alleged discriminatory action.

All Title VI complaints filed directly with North East Transportation will be referred to the Title VI Coordinator. Complaints must be in writing, signed by the complainant or a representative, and include the complainants name, address, and telephone number, or other means by which the complainant may be contacted. Complaints shall explain as fully as possible the facts and circumstances surrounding the alleged discriminatory action, and identify the individual(s) and/or organization(s) responsible for the alleged discriminatory action. In cases where the complainant is assisted in converting an oral complaint into a written complaint, the complainant is required to sign the written complaint. All discrimination complaints will be acknowledged in writing. Complaints received by telephone will be reduced to writing and provided to the complainant for confirmation, revision, and signature before processing.

The Title VI designee or the individual receiving the written complaint will review the complaint to ensure that the required information is provided, the complaint is timely, and is written within the appropriate jurisdiction. The complaint will be accepted unless it is withdrawn, not filed within the allowed time period, or the complainant fails to provide required information after a written request for omitted/additional information.

In addition to filing a Title VI complaint with North East Transportation, a Title VI complaint may also be filed directly with CTDOT or the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) for transit related complaints at the addresses listed below.
